Our Course Key Facts:

- 1. Assessment starts from £35 + VAT for a Fleet of 20+ D/R. For a single 3.5hr theory session start from £44 + VAT. (Price differs below Fleet of 20)

We do this at the start of training, and at the end, so you can measure their progress and overall skill level as a driver.

How a Course Runs:

All our courses are road and classroom -based, and preferable take place in a drivers own car / van / motorbike. The course is bespoke and based on the needs of the driver of the company, although follows a set format, which covers:

1. An Initial Drive/Ride – This allows our tutors to assess the driver's level of experience and skill after the initial introductions and vehicle safety checks. We ask a driver's to drive or ride the way they normally do with no input from the tutor, for around 20 minutes.

We then mark them in 25 areas of driver, either Consistently High, High with Occasional Lapses, Satisfactory or Needs improvement. This forms an excellent basis to build on the session, as both the driver/rider and tutor can see the areas, which need the most development. This helps create a truly bespoke training session.

- **2. Coaching** Based on the initial drive, the coaching will be designed around the needs and requirements of the driver, in an interactive and enjoyable way according to the learning skills of each driver. We will be driving/riding on a range of roads including urban driving, out of town (rural) driving, and motorway/dual carriageways. During this session, there will be a chance for two-way feedback, along with opportunities to recap what has been covered.
- **3. Debrief** At the end of the course there will be a two way debrief, where the tutor will provide feedback on the session, and where feedback from the driver/rider is also encouraged. The tutor will again mark the driver on the 25 driving areas, which were looked at on the initial driving, making it very easy to see how the driver/rider has improved, to what extent, and in what areas.

We provide a risk assessment for each driver at the end, which will be **1** = Consistently High **2** = High with Occasional Lapses **3** = Satisfactory **4** = Needs improvement. A pdf report will be sent to you around 3 days after each training session.
